

Following is the criteria for **Overage Player Exemptions**

Reasons for consideration:

- > Never played before
- Disability
- > Date of Birth (within days of cut off)
- Exceptional circumstances

Assessment Criteria

Any player nominated for overage status will be initially (and continually) assessed throughout the season in the areas outlined below. In the case the BJFL believe the player to be in breach of this criteria, the exemption may be revoked at any time during the current season.

Factors to be taken into account include, but may not be limited to:

- 1. Ability to influence the game:
 - 1. General Motor Skills
 - a) Coordination
 - b) Speed and Agility
 - 2. General Football Skills
 - a) Marking
 - b) Kicking
 - c) Ball Handling
- 2. Ability to influence others:
 - 1. Conduct
 - a) Plays in accordance with AFL Victoria Country, BJFL & Club Codes of Conduct
 - 2. Behaviour
 - b) Does not display an aggressive nature towards other players.

Note: If granted, the exemption player cannot replace an eligible aged player in the team (maximum numbers).
